

Camp Lewis Men Get Permits To Hear Opera Co.

Major General Greene, commanding Camp Lewis, has given his permission for the officers and men stationed here to attend the operas which will be presented at the Tacoma theater Friday and Saturday nights by the La Scala Grand Opera Co. All those at the cantonment desiring to attend either Friday or Saturday night will be granted special leave of absence by applying at the commander's headquarters for a permit.

A special train will carry the officers and men back to the camp after the opera.

The opening night's attraction is Verdi's "Rigoletto," with Nina Morgana in the role of Gilda. The cast will include Mario Valle, baritone, who will sing Rigoletto, the hunchback jester. Pelade Sinagra will be seen as the Duke, while Italo Picchi, leading basso of the La Scala company, will be heard as Sparafucile.

At the Saturday matinee a magnificent revival of "Carmen" will be presented with Ester Ferrabini in the title role.

On Saturday night, which has been designated as military night in honor of the soldiers at Camp Lewis, "Il Trovatore" will be sung with Andrea Arensen in the role of Manrico and Josephine Rondero in the role of Leonora.
