

## GRAND OPERA SINGERS COMING

### University Invites Commencement Week Guests to Concert.

The concert to be given under the auspices of Phi Mu Alpha Wednesday, June 3, will be an addition to the program for Commencement Week. Mlle. Jenny Dufau, coloratura soprano, Enrico Aresoni, dramatic tenor, and Martin Bruhl, concert pianist, will give the program. This is not a part of the regular concert series, but has been added this year for Commencement Week and the seventy-fifth anniversary of the University. The guests of the University during Commencement Week will be admitted free. The University will pay for their seats.

Mlle. Dufau and Enrico Aresoni will give solos accompanied by Bruhl. Bruhl will play a piano solo. There will be about a dozen numbers on the program. The two singers are grand opera singers.

Mlle. Dufau was here April 6 in the regular concert series, and greatly pleased those who heard her. Last season she was with the Chicago Grand Opera Company. She has been engaged by a Paris grand opera company to sing at the Convent Garden in London. Next year she will be first soprano with the Chicago-Philadelphia Grand Opera Company. Enrico Aresoni will be first tenor in the same company next year. Martin Bruhl is a concert pianist from Chicago.

The price of admission to hear these artists is less than for the regular concerts. The entire lower floor of the Auditorium will be reserved, tickets to be sold for \$1 each. The general admission will be 50 cents. Tickets will be put on sale at 9 o'clock Saturday morning at the Co-op and at the Allen Music Company.
